FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q Why Engaged Encounter?

A Couples often get so busy preparing for the wedding that they may not find time to simply "be with each other". The Engaged Encounter weekend is an experience that allows for time to examine and to deepen their relationship with each other and with God, away from the distractions of daily life. It prepares the couple for the *marriage* that follows the wedding day.

Q Who attends Engaged Encounter?

A Engaged Couples who have a definite commitment to one another are invited to attend. The weekend is primarily designed for couples planning to marry in the Catholic Church, but those planning an interfaith marriage or Christian marriage in another church are also welcome.

Q What happens on the weekend?

A Married couples and a priest, a deacon, or a consecrated religious woman or man will share personal experiences and reflections related to marriage and family. These talks are designed to bring out important issues regarding marriage. Each engaged couple will privately share their reflections on a list of questions. In this way, the couples are guided to mutual self-discovery of their future

Q Do we have to do a lot of group sharing?

A NO! The focus of this weekend is on you and your relationship with one another. With other couples, you will listen to talks, eat meals, and attend Mass together, but much of the weekend is devoted to your private reflection time with your future mate.

Q How long is the retreat? What is the cost?

A The weekend begins on Friday evening and ends on Sunday in the afternoon. This could be the most important and rewarding time you could devote to preparing for your future marriage.

The cost is \$225 for the weekend. A \$150 deposit is due at the time of registration. The remaining \$75 is payable at the retreat.
